All Saints Primary School

The Ofsted inspection of All Saints found that “this school requires special measures because it is failing to give its pupils an acceptable standard of education.” It was scored as “satisfactory” for pupil behaviour but the lowest score of “inadequate” for all the other criteria of pupil achievement, quality of teaching and leadership and management. Its overall effectiveness was scored as “inadequate.” The school will have to develop an action plan to improve in these areas to the satisfaction of Ofsted inspectors who will return to check on progress. The deputy head is acting headteacher assisted by an Executive Head who is working four days a week. New arrangements will be put in place for a permanent headteacher and overall control of the school.

Isobel Blackman Centre

Following last year’s valuation of the re-opened Centre, now as a community hub as well as a day-care centre, new plans have been agreed to take on board the evaluation’s recommendations. A new specification for running the whole centre will be worked up with the aim of getting one organisation to take over all elements of it – day care, café, community use. A decision will be made by September. I did ask for user and carer input into the process and this has been agreed. The single successful organisation will take over by January.
